



TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS 25 °C, unless otherwise noted




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
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




Forward Diode Voltage vs. Temperature









Threshold Voltage

Single Pulse Power







Power Dissipation (W)

^{*} The power dissipation P_D is based on $T_{J(max)} = 150$ °C, using junction-to-case thermal resistance, and is more useful in settling the upper dissipation limit for cases where additional heatsinking is used. It is used to determine the current rating, when this rating falls below the package limit.


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TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS 25 °C, unless otherwise noted
